- 1. A **REJECTION** of **ALL** Western knowledge, science, culture and civilisation, because there are many **positive** aspects and contributions of Western scholarship, techniques and systems, etc., that are acceptable or should be adapted or emulated by contemporary Muslims.
- 2. A **DISCOURAGEMENT** of learning or benefitting from modern science and technology. Muslims ought to learn and excel in science and technology as Fard Kifāyah knowledge from the perspective of the Signs of Allah (SWT) in the cosmos, in history and in society.²



"Among **His Signs** is this, that He created you from dust; and then,- behold, ye are men scattered (far and wide)! And among **His Signs** is this, that He created for you mates from among yourselves, that ye may dwell in tranquillity with them, and He has put love and mercy between your (hearts): verily in that are **Signs** for those who reflect. And among **His Signs** is the creation of the heavens and the earth, and the variations in your languages and your colours: verily in that are **Signs** for those who know." (Q. al-Rūm, 30: 20-22).

"Among **His Signs** is this, that He sends the Winds, as heralds of Glad Tidings, giving you a taste of His (Grace and) Mercy,- that the ships may sail (majestically) by His Command and that ye may seek of His Bounty: in order that ye may be grateful." (Q. Fuṣṣilat, 41: 53).

"Mocked were (many) apostles before thee; but their scoffers were hemmed in by the thing that they mocked. Say: 'Travel through the earth and See what was the end of those who rejected Truth'. Say: 'To whom belongeth all that is in the heavens and on earth?' Say: 'To Allah. He hath inscribed for Himself (the rule of) Mercy. That He will gather you together for the Day of Judgment, there is no doubt whatever. It is they who have lost their own souls, that will not believe" (Q. Āl 'Imrān, 3: 77).
