

List of LMD Courses and Course Synopsis

Foundation in Arabic for International Communication (ARCOM)

Course	Synopsis
Al-Naḥw wa Al-Ṣarf (AISF 0314)	This course helps students to enhance their Arabic grammar and morphology for basic communication. It equips students with basic grammar and morphological features. These include conjugations, word derivations and verbal nouns, construction of basic sentences in Arabic as well as to enrich their vocabulary. The course also exposes students to grammatical analyses through various Arabic texts. As a result of learning this course, students will be able to construct sentences with correct grammar and morphology in academic writing.
Mahārāt al-Taqdīm (AISF 0524)	This course is specifically designed for students to acquire basic skills in presentations for academic context using the Arabic language. This course provides tasks that enable students to achieve Arabic communicative competence and develop poise and confidence in delivering presentations.
Madkhal ilā Ma‘ārif Al-Waḥy Wa Al-Turāth Al-Islāmī (AISF 0434)	The course explores the meanings, nature and main features of <i>al-Waḥy</i> namely <i>al-Qur’ān</i> , and <i>al-Ḥadīth</i> and its authority. The course also covers discussions on <i>al-Tawḥīd</i> , Islamic legislation and Islamic heritage, and its significance, and the necessity to adhere to its principles. At the end of the course, students are expected to familiarise on the notion that the Qur’ān and the Sunnah are two complementary revelations that serve as unbreakable sources of knowledge, thought, and civilisation.
Al-Qirā’ah al-Muwassa‘ah (LMAF 0514)	This course will introduce students to a systematic way of approaching and understanding Arabic texts with emphasis on vocabulary, reading strategies and text comprehension. This course also will expose them to the origin of the Arabic language and how it evolves over time. They will learn how the features of Arabic have developed from one period to another and contribution of selected scholars during their period.
Al-Kitābah al-Waḏīfiyyah (LMAF 0524)	This course is designed to help students develop effective basic writing skills with close attention to grammar and style, organization,

	and syntax. This course also emphasises on vocabulary and writing strategies in developing content.
Mahārāt al-Tawāṣul Bi al-Lughah al-‘Arabīyyah (LMAF 0534)	This course emphasizes the relations of language studies and communication. It describes the usage of language in different settings of communication by demonstrating the language competency and communication skills.

Foundation in English for International Communication (ENCOM)

Course	Synopsis

<p>Etiquettes in Tourism (LMTF 0534)</p>	<p>The aim of the course is to equip students with the essential guide to etiquettes in tourism. This course introduces the foundations of communication, dressing and grooming, technology, dining, social, networking and cross-cultural etiquettes. Students will be exposed to the importance of etiquettes in everyday life for professional success in the tourism industry in line with the Islamic approach.</p>
