



# **ANNEX**

# a) GUIDELINES

Criteria for application for sponsorship presenting paper in local conference or publish in index journal:

- 1. All full-time or part-time postgraduate students of IIUM.
- 2. A minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or excellent progress report (students who finished at least the 2nd semester of their studies only would be considered).
- 3. A student who is on "leave of absence" is not entitled to apply.
- 4. An applicant must be a "registered student" during application and while presenting a paper in the conference.
- 5. The application must get recommendations from student's supervisor.
- 6. A student is entitled to present a paper with approved University budget in conference only ONCE (RM500.00 capped) in his level (Master/ PhD programme) of studies.
- 7. Application must be submitted to CPS at least two (2) weeks before the date of conference.
- 8. The applicant MUST present a paper in the Scopus/Web of Science (WoS)/ERA/MYCITE/etc. indexed conferences.
